

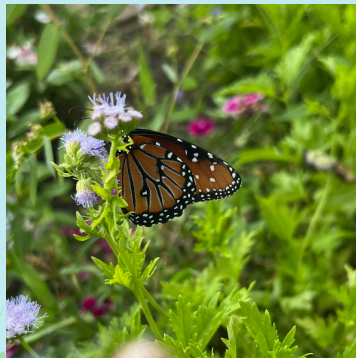
WHAT IS THE "GREEN TEAM"?
